What is WIC?

WIC is a federally-funded health and nutrition program for women, infants, and children. WIC helps families by providing coupons for buying healthy supplemental foods from WIC-authorized vendors, nutrition education, and help finding healthcare and other community services.

Who is eligible?

Participants must be:

- pregnant women
- breastfeeding women
- new mothers
- infants
- children under age five

Where do I have to live?

Our WIC Program serves Stickney Township Residents that live in:

- Burbank
- Central Stickney
- Forest View
- Nottingham Park
- Stickney

Are there Income Guidelines?

Participants must meet income guidelines. To be eligible on the basis of income, applicants' income must fall at or below 185% of the U.S. Poverty Income Guidelines (currently \$42,643 for a family of four).

A person who participates or has family members who participate in certain other benefit programs, such as SNAP, Medicaid, or TANF, automatically meets the income eligibility requirement.

What Foods Does WIC Provide?

- Infant cereal
- Adult iron-fortified cereal
- Vitamin C- rich fruit/vegetable juice
- Eggs
- Milk
- Cheese
- Peanut butter
- Dried and canned beans/peas
- Canned fish
- Baby foods
- Whole wheat bread and other whole grain options
- Vouchers for fresh, canned, or frozen fruit/vegetables

WIC recognizes and promotes breastfeeding as the optimal source of nutrition for infants. For women who do not fully breastfeed, WIC provides iron-fortified formula. Special infant formulas and medical foods may be provided when prescribed by a physician for a specified medical condition.
